American Airlines FLIGHT 11

7:59 AM: Takes off from Boston, MA.

8:46 AM: Crashes into the North Tower of the World Trade Center.

10:28 AM: The North Tower of the World Trade Center collapses.

United Airlines FLIGHT 175

8:14 AM: Takes off from Boston, MA.

9:03 AM: Crashes into the South Tower of the World Trade Center.

9:58 AM: The South Tower of the World Trade Center collapses.

American Airlines FLIGHT 77

8:20 AM: Takes off from Washington, DC.


9:37 AM: Crashes into the Pentagon.

10:15 AM: E-Ring of the Pentagon collapses.

United Airlines FLIGHT 93

8:42 AM: Takes off from Newark, NJ.

10:03 AM: Crashes into a field in Shanksville, PA.



U.S. HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

9:00 AM: Morning Hour begins on the House Floor with five-minute speeches.

House committees begin hearings.

9:20 AM: The House recesses.

9:45 AM: Capitol Police begin evacuation of the Capitol complex.

9:52 AM: Presided by Speaker pro tempore Porter Goss of Florida, the House reconvenes. The guest chaplain, the Rev. Gerrard Creedon, offers the prayer.

9:53 AM: The House recesses. All Federal buildings are evacuated.

7:15 PM: Members of the House and the Senate gather on the east front steps of the Capitol for a press conference and sing "God Bless America."
