AN ACT

To enable the people of Oklahoma and of the Indian Territory to form a constitution and State government and be admitted into the Union on an equal footing with the original States; and to enable the people of New Mexico and of Arizona to form a constitution and State government and be admitted into the Union on an equal footing with the original States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the inhabitants of all that part of the area of the United
4 States now constituting the Territory of Oklahoma and the
5 Indian Territory, as at present described, may adopt a consti-
6 tution and become the State of Oklahoma, as hereinafter pro-
7 vided: *Provided,* That nothing contained in the said consti-
8 tution shall be construed to limit or impair the rights of person
9 or property pertaining to the Indians of said Territories (so
10 long as such rights shall remain unextinguished) or to limit
11 or affect the authority of the Government of the United States
